



Fellowship Kids Drive-Thru Easter Storybook FAQs

Q: *What is a Drive-Thru Easter Storybook?*

A: Traditionally, Fellowship Church has hosted an Easter Celebration with games & activities, egg hunts & prizes, an Easter Story presentation etc., as a way of showing our love and care for those in our community. But due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, we have found a new way to celebrate the good news of Easter with our community! Families are invited to drive onto our church campus on Saturday, April 4 between 1pm and 3pm to view six themed car trunks that will tell the story of Easter in scripture! We will provide each visiting car with a Story Card to guide you through the story and a Goody Bag for each child 5th grade and under in your car as you exit!

Q: *Why are you having this event at such a time as this?*

A: As the church, we are compelled to share the good news of Jesus Christ with our community. We also care deeply about the families in our area, and hope this is a fun, enriching activity to do together! Understand that we respect our governing bodies and are working within their guidelines to reach out to our neighbors in this safe and loving way.

Q: *Is it ok for us to attend this event when PA is under a 'Stay at Home Order'?*

A: Churches are classified as a religious institutions and are therefore exempt from the 'Stay at Home Order'. However, we plan to follow the recommended guidelines for social distancing and there will be extremely limited and safe contact, or 0% contact if a Drive Thru participant chooses to not receive the items that are distributed. That is your choice and we will respect that.

Governor Wolf is simply encouraging religious institutions to exercise discretion in order to mitigate the spread of illness. It is for that reason that we have created this event for the families of our area with health and safety measures at the forefront.

Q: What are the safety measures that you have in place for this event?

A: All visitors to this event should remain in their cars at all times. They should simply drive through and view the decorated trunks - there will not be any interaction at the trunks. However, **volunteers** who will be handing out the Story Cards (at the beginning) and the Goody Bags (at the end), will be **wearing gloves** and not touching anything except the items they are handing off, then stepping back a further distance to answer any questions a visitor may have.

Those volunteers are instructed to maintain a **safe distance** to each other as well as to all visitors. **The Goody Bags will have been packed by clean, sanitized, gloved hands.** The Church will not be open for the public to enter or use facilities at this event, except for the handful of volunteers running the event.

Q: Where do we enter the church campus? And where do we go once there?

A: Fellowship Church is located at 45 Hildebrandt Road, in Dallas, near the Dallas schools. There will be one way in and one way out...simply watch for the signs and the traffic attendants that will guide you. Once you enter the campus, simply follow the signs and the traffic attendants (who will be wearing vests). Because traffic will be one-way throughout, there'll be no problem knowing where to go. Just follow the car in front of you, at a safe distance and a pace that you and your family are able to read along on the Story Card that you'll receive at the entrance. Once you have viewed all the trunks, look for the Goody Bags at the end.

Q: How many Goody Bags do we get? Can I take more for kids at home?

A: We will have a limited amount of Goody Bags, and therefore can only distribute one to each child, 5th grade and under, in your car.
