

Fellowship Community Group Discussion Guide

Week of April 28

“Courageous Faith All the Way to End” | Joshua 14

Opening Connection: *Go around the room and ask each person to give their name and answer. The Discussion Leader is welcome to make up a question.*

- If you were to get a surprise day off how would you use it?
- What's one memory you have with a long-time friend?

Sermon Text and Content Question Ideas: *Discuss the content of the text and ask your own follow-up questions as the discussion unfolds.*

- Open up to Joshua 14:1-5 Ask a volunteer to read it out loud.
- What are some of the indications in the text that remind us God is allocating the land?

Read: Joshua 14:6-12

- What was Caleb's story? Can someone give a summary of some of the points?
- What is it about Caleb that gives him courageous faith?
- How does Caleb testify to God's faithfulness? What could he have done instead?

Read: Joshua 14:13-15

- What was the result of Caleb's request
- Why is it significant that Caleb is given Hebron specifically?

Discussion/Application Question Ideas: *Focus now on applying the content of the message.*

- What does it take for us to be fully after the Lord?
- What is something that has held you back from being fully after the Lord?
- Why do we find it difficult to tell stories about God's faithfulness in our life?
- Have you ever been encouraged by someone else's testimony of God's faithfulness? What about it encouraged you?
- What is a time that God was faithful in your life that you could share?
- Who is one person you could share a testimony with this week of God's faithfulness in your life?
- How would our interactions change if we talked about God's faithfulness more?
- What are some of the promises for the future that God has given to all believers?
- In what ways might you be tempted to coast in life and walking with God?
- What is the next challenge that God is calling you to take on with courageous faith?
- How do the promises of God help us live with courageous faith today?

Prayer Together

- Ask for a volunteer to be the last person to pray, and have a time of prayer together, with a few different people praying.
- Pray for God's Word to bear fruit in your lives, in light of what you have discussed.
