


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- Christ arrived as a high priest of the New Covenant

24 For Christ has entered, not into holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true things, but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf.



- He entered the eternal sanctuary in heaven
- The tabernacle in the Old Testament was a representation of this place

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
- By means of His own blood

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


Christ Gave Himself to Purify Us for God

- The Levitical priests sprinkled a person for cleansing

- Ritual cleansing of the body

13 For if the blood of goats and bulls, and the sprinkling of defiled persons with the ashes of a heifer, sanctify for the purification of the flesh,



9 This is an illustration for the present time, indicating that the gifts and sacrifices being offered were not able to clear the conscience of the worshiper. 10 They are only a matter of food and drink and various ceremonial washings—external regulations applying until the time of the new order.
